Dear fellow travelers,

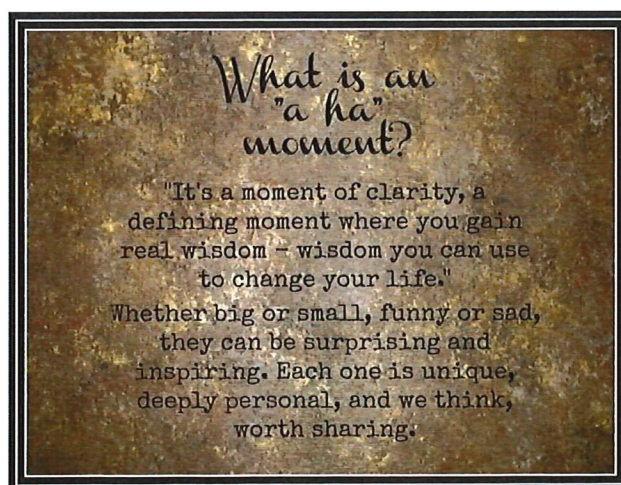
